MESSAGE FROM FATHER WILSON

Dear Friends in Christ,

Today on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we must confess that the doctrine of the Most Holy Trinity is indeed a great truth and yet an ineffable mystery. Thinking of our future life within the Trinity, the Apostle Paul wrote: "What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man conceived, what God has prepared for those who love him," (I Cor 2:9)

Throughout the liturgical year we see God in his expressions of tenderness, mercy, love and justice in the various epiphanies. Today we look at the Godhead, in its essence. The liturgy attempts to show us the mystery of the intimate life of God, who fills the heavens with his omnipresence, sends his Son to be born of a woman, and has the humility to send his disciples to the ends of the earth to preach and baptize in his name. A distant God he may seem, but who else could say that his Creator has become one like us? By the incarnation, he introduces us to the mystery of his life to such an extent that we can respond to Him in familiar terms.

The Church is the family of the adopted children of God, and one of the things revealed to us is the mystery of the Trinity, i.e., that God is a community of love - a family. That is why the Bible uses three words: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, to help us understand in some way the mystery of the Divine life of the Trinity.

The Holy Trinity is the central doctrine of our faith. We may not fully understand this doctrine, but we should wrestle with it, contemplate the mystery and ultimately accept it in faith. The truth is, if we truly understood the Holy Trinity and all that it means, we would be God and...we are not. May we remember St. Peter's statement of faith: "Lord to whom shall we go, you have the words of everlasting life." (John 6:68)
