MESSAGE FROM FATHER

Dear Friends in Christ,

In our Gospel for this Sunday, the Pharisees continue their efforts to trap Jesus into saying something that they could use to get him out of the way. They again questioned Christ in attempt to get him to “paint himself into a corner,” but Jesus was able to turn it around on his critics. Asking for a coin, Jesus asked them whose likeness and inscription were on it. When they answered that it was Caesar’s, Jesus responded: “Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.” (Matt 22:21)

As faithful Catholics we are bound to submit to civil authorities, who exercise their authority in secular matters for the common good. However, should the demands of civil authorities run contrary to the moral law, human dignity, or a properly formed conscience, the faithful also have an obligation to refuse obedience to any law that makes them complicit in sin.

Sadly, we now live in a land that has legalized abortion right up to the day before birth, recognized homosexual unions as “marriage,” and allows for euthanasia in several states. These are laws that belong to a “corrupt Caesar” and we must not be complicit in supporting them in any way. May we be known for our “work of faith and labor of love and endurance in hope of our Lord Jesus Christ, before our God and Father,” (I Thess 1:3)

A Brief Financial Update

Parish Accounting System

Most of you know that Michelle Derek resigned as our bookkeeper in the third week of August. She decided that she wanted to pursue some other personal interests and we wish her all the best.

Since that time, Kathleen and Monica have been doing double duty keeping up with the absolute essential tasks to keep the parish running. After consultation with the Finance Council, I decided to avail ourselves of the Parish Accounting System that the Diocese offers. It's a bookkeeping system used by about 45 other parishes throughout the Diocese and means that the Diocese will handle our bookkeeping and payroll responsibilities. There is a small monthly charge for this, but the net result is that we will save about \$10,000 per year in payroll expenses.

Also, you may have seen that we haven't had the weekly financial update published in the bulletin. This too is a function of not having a bookkeeper on site. In a nutshell, our offerings have been increasing since the middle of July and particularly since we added the Vigil Mass. So, we are doing better with our weekly contributions...we are not where we should be, but we are making progress. Thanks so much for your generosity! As soon as we get up and running with the Parish Accounting System, we will again publish a weekly update on our collections. If you have any questions, please stop by the parish office.

Bicentennial Capital Campaign

Our Bicentennial Capital Campaign was concluded last fall. We currently have something like \$623,000 in pledges and about \$125,000 in cash at the Diocese. Since that time, however the case elements or the projects on which we will spend the money, have changed. Three case elements were submitted to the Diocese: new flooring for the church, a new organ and a new rectory. While we still need new flooring, the need for the other two case elements no longer exists. We have repaired the organ and do not need to buy another one. And...there is no need to build a new rectory. The current rectory is very comfortable and I love living there! It does need some renovation and upgrades, but it is a solid, comfortable and convenient place to live. I'm most grateful that you have provided me with that such a nice place to live!

Accordingly, we need to rework our case elements for the Capital Campaign. I am in the process of reconstituting our Bicentennial Capital Campaign Committee to refocus our case elements for our parish. This committee will include the original members of the team who are still available along with three or four more members. Currently the Committee would include Mike Kantz, Andrew Harris, Ferd Fernandez, Ray Glinski, Roy Kibler, Joyce Thomas, Lynn Pownall and one other from the parish. This Committee will solicit input from the parish as to the appropriate case elements for the Capital Campaign and will submit it to the parish Finance Council. Upon approval by the Finance Council, we will ask parishioners to recommit their pledge to the new case elements and encourage others who did not pledge, to make their pledge.

To all those who made those generous contributions to the Capital Campaign, I deeply thank you!! Our Lady of Peace is our portion of God's vineyard. Please pray about what your part can be in this critical work.
